



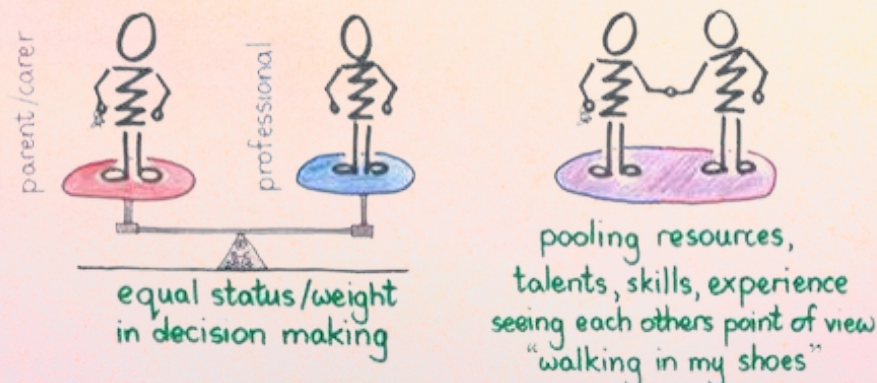

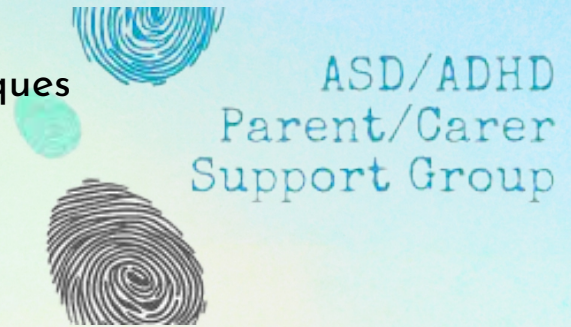
CO-PRODUCTION what does it mean?



Parents will feel listened to, supported and confident to become equal partners in shaping our service that will achieve better outcomes for the whole family.

The Family Support Programme offers an introduction followed by a flexible learning programme that will address:

- ASD and ADHD and behaviours that are challenging
- EHCPs and the Local Offer
- Sensory overload, tools and techniques
- Sleep deprivation
- Family needs, wants and choices



The programme is designed to:

- Build family resilience
- Empower and enable families to have a greater understanding and to share with others
- Increase engagement and participation of families to have a greater voice, helping to shape local services
- Raise aspirations and quality of life, enabling families to be the best they can be

APTCOO will ensure parents, carers including extended family members are able to learn as equals on a journey of discovery.
